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# Workshop Introduction

The evaluation process has identified common problems with regard to the implementation of centralised biobanking infrastructures:

- Ethical aspects have been dealt with in quite different ways (Common ethics best practice to be developed?)
- Project specific patient consent (Implementation of a generic patient consent where possible)

# Common Problems

- Transfer issues must be further advanced.
- Access policies (Common ethics access policies to be developed?)
- Data security (Advancement by cooperative discussion and exploration of common solutions)
- Missing independent external advisory committees (Establishment of overseeing policies)
- Second site storage is often neglected (issue to be discussed)
